HOW TO APPLY

1. Create an account on Abroad Office— <http://ashland.abroadoffice.net>
2. On the left, choose 2018 AU Programs, then the AU in France page. Click Apply to Program and complete application information.
3. Attend four Pre-Departure meetings, beginning in January.



ABOUT AU IN FRANCE

The AU in France Program in Annecy, France (FREN 200/300) is a program designed to provide students with an immersion experience. Students will attend four hours of language instruction per day at *Institut Français des Alpes (IFALPES)* in Annecy, France. For additional cultural experiences, students will participate in excursions and live with French families. Students earn 6 semester hours of credit during this six-week program.

ESTIMATED EXPENSES (costs subject to change)

Program Cost: \$3,652

INCLUDED: Ashland University summer tuition (6 credits), single room with a host family, 2 meals a day provided by host family, weekly laundry service, weekly on-campus activities, international health insurance and textbooks.

NOT INCLUDED: Flight and airport transfers (approx. \$1400), passport (\$135), meals not provided (lunches and snacks, approx. \$20/day), bus card (35 Euros), spending money and independent travel.

COURSES AVAILABLE

FREN 200 Intensive Intermediate French Study (6 credit hours)
FREN 300 Intensive Advanced French Study (6 credit hours)

PREREQUISITE: Successful completion of FREN 151 & 152 or equivalent

ACADEMIC DETAILS

Students in FREN 200 or FREN 300 receive three credit hours for each three weeks of French study. Prior to departure, students participate in orientation sessions at Ashland University. At *Institut Français des Alpes (IFALPES)*, students are placed in a class commensurate with her/his abilities, based on the results of a written and oral assessment. Course content will be determined by the needs of the student(s). Students will be evaluated weekly by the instructor. Upon returning to Ashland University, students participate in a debriefing session with the faculty director. An additional afternoon language class will be available for students who need help to reach the intermediate level.

Successful completion of FREN 200 (6 hrs.) fulfills the CCI requirement, but may not cover the exact concepts covered in FREN 251 and 252. Students planning to continue their study of French may be required to take FREN 251 on campus before enrolling in 300-level French classes.
