This unique summer travel experience takes students on a **three-week** journey to Germany, visiting sights that cover the range of German history. The program has offered annually since 2005, with over 160 students taking advantage of this great opportunity. Students travel Germany with fellow Ashland students, earning **six summer credits** through AU courses taught by AU professors. This program also **fulfills the CCI Requirement**.

## DEADLINES & PAYMENTS

**November 1** – Submit deposit for Early Bird Grant

**December 1** – \$500 Non-refundable deposit due in Bixler 211

**February 1** – Remaining balance charged to AU account (non-refundable)

- Interest-free until departure date

## HOW TO APPLY

**Submit \$500 non-refundable deposit**, check made out to Ashland University or a debit/credit card, to the Study Abroad Office (Bixler 211) prior to the deadline.

## ESTIMATED PROGRAM COST

**Approximately \$5,295**

**INCLUDED:** Two Ashland courses (six summer credit hours), airfare, double room, excursion package, international health insurance, kitchen/laundry access, local lecturers, group airport shuttle in-country, daily breakfast, five dinners in Wittenberg, four dinners during the weekend excursions, rental bike, and trips tips for tour directors, divers and guides.

**NOT INCLUDED:** Ashland University housing during the first week of classes (approx. \$10 per day), meals not included (approx. \$10 per meal), expense for passport (\$145), ETIAS travel visa (\$7-\$9), and personal expenses (est. \$700-\$1000).

## PRICE COMPARISON

- 2 Summer Courses on Ashland Campus with housing = \$3,192
- 2 Summer Courses with AU in Germany Program = \$4,998

## TENTATIVE ITINERARY

Week 1	Attend Class Sessions at Ashland University and Depart for Wittenberg, Germany on Friday, May 12.
Weeks 2 & 3	Attend Class Sessions, Evening Cultural Activities, and short Excursions.
Week 4	Excursion Week: Day Trip to Berlin and Overnight Excursions to Weimar, Buchenwald Concentration Camp, Erfurt, and Eisenach Castle. Depart Germany on June 2.
