## ABOUT STUDENT TEACHING ABROAD

Ashland University's College of Education's Cross-Cultural internships in Teacher Education (CITE) Program offers pre-service teachers the opportunity to complete their student teaching requirement internationally. Students are assigned to an international school that utilizes English as the language of instruction. CITE offers a unique opportunity for students to expand their multicultural awareness and understanding. Candidates may be prospective teachers for the following licensure areas: Early Childhood, Middle Childhood, Adolescent/Young Adults, Intervention Specialist, Multi-Age. Students teach for 6 weeks abroad and 6 weeks in the USA.

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- At least a 3.0 cumulative GPA
- At least at 3.0 GPA in professional education
- No Level 1-2 judicial violations within one year
- Program Team/Major Department Recommendation
- Submission of COST Program application and required forms
- Interview with COE STA Selection Committee
