### **ABOUT STUDENT TEACHING**

Ashland University's College of Education offers pre-service teachers the opportunity to complete their student teaching requirement internationally. Students are assigned to an international school that utilizes English as the language of instruction. Student teaching abroad offers a unique opportunity for students to expand their multicultural awareness and understanding. Students teach for 7 weeks abroad and 7 weeks in the USA.

Accommodations will vary depending on location. Some participants live with a family, while others live with other students/teachers, on campus or make separate arrangements to live on their own. COST participants are responsible for all their living expenses.
