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ABOUT THE CLOTHING & CULTURE STUDY TOUR

The course, FM 211 Clothing & Culture, explores the social, psychological, and cultural aspects of clothing and appearance. It includes the relationships of clothing and appearance to physical and social environments, aesthetic and personal expression, and cultural ideas & values. This study tour is pending CCI Course with Study Away approval.

Clothing and culture examines dress in cultures around the world. The systematic study of dress includes classifying universal types of dress and their properties. The impact of the environment on dress is explored. Examining the relationship between cultural scale and dress shows the influence of the size of the culture on patterns of a cultural group. The study of aesthetics and dress shows interpretations in ideals and standards of beauty.

TENTATIVE ITINERARY CONTENT (subject to change)

"Birth of Fashion" tour all over Paris, meet with a Parisian designer, explore Centre Pompidou, tour of Marais Quarter, walk through the Museum of Fashion - The Palais Galliera, visit textile/fashion and design industries, meet with a Parisian stylist, shop at the Marché aux Puces de la Porte De Vanves market, walking tour of Paris street art, attend a fashion management presentation on the ethical fashion industry, visit an organic fashion production, enjoy a presentation on luxury fashion, uncover the French craft scene, and take time to explore the area!


