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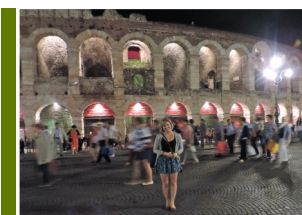
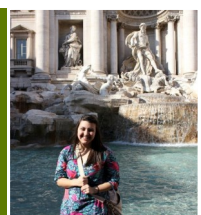

## HOW TO APPLY

1. Create an account on Abroad Office—<http://ashland.abroadoffice.net>
2. On the left, choose 2015 AU Programs, then HS 221: Food and Culture of Italy. Click Apply to Program and complete application information.
3. **Submit deposit** to the Global Education Office [100 Founders] prior to the deadline.



## ABOUT HS 221: CUISINE AND CULTURE OF ITALY

This Study Tour is available to all students and community members (with a preference to students enrolled in HS 221). Traveling to Italy will provide students with the opportunity to experience a culture in depth, with a focus on foods of the area. To prepare, students will complete the course project on an Italian topic to be further researched in Italy. In Sansepolcro, students will learn to cook authentic Italian food with a Tuscan cook. In addition, they will be able to experience the culture of the locals by exploring areas such as the Assisi and Perugia, Museo Civico, Anghiari and Arezzo, and the local street market. After being immersed in the local culture of Sansepolcro, students will travel to Rome where they can visit sites such as the Vatican and St. Peter's Basilica, the Roman Forums and the Coliseum, and local landmarks such as the Trevi Fountain and the Pantheon. Students will return to the US with vast knowledge of Italian food and culture.

## ESTIMATED PROGRAM COST

**Program Cost: \$3,165** (Increased airline fuel charges could raise the price)

**INCLUDED:** Airfare, housing accommodations (dormitories in Sansepolcro and hotel in Rome), ground transportation in Italy, all breakfasts, 5 lunches, 1 dinner, entrance to sites listed in itinerary, 2 cooking courses (2 groups of 10), tips, on site support, and international health insurance.

**NOT INCLUDED:** Transportation to and from Ohio airport, other meals not specified (approx. \$150 for 6 dinners and 1 lunch Rome), \$35 background check fee for Meredith College, trip interruption and cancellation insurance, and personal expenses.

**February 1** – Remaining balance charged to AU account
