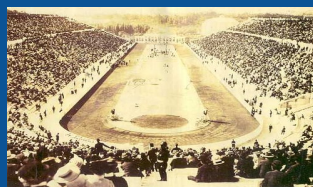

## PROGRAM INFORMATION

Dr. Chris Swanson, Professor of Mathematics and Director of the Honors Program, will lead a group of AU Honors students to Greece in May 2019. This multi-city tour will provide students with the opportunity to experience firsthand the cultures of Greece. This tour is tied to the Spring 2019 Honors 390: Honors Interdisciplinary Seminar course, in which students will study various works with ties to Greece. Students in Honors 390 will complete journals and CCI narratives based on their experiences on the trip.

## ESTIMATED PROGRAM COST

**PROGRAM COST: \$3,378** (Note: Increased airline fuel charges could raise the price)

**INCLUDED:** Airfare, accommodations, international health insurance, breakfasts and some meals (9 breakfasts & 7 dinners), guides, tips, admission to sites listed on the itinerary, and in-country transportation.

**NOT INCLUDED:** Expenses for passport, trip cancellation and interruption insurance, meals not specified above, and personal expenses.

## TENTATIVE ITINERARY

DATE	LOCATION	PROGRAM
5/6-7	Travel	Travel to Athens, Greece. Upon airport arrival, guided to hotel for the night.
5/8	Athens	Visit of the Acropolis and many architectural wonders including the Parthenon. Panoramic view of the city and market-place of ancient philosophers. Afterwards, a bus tour in the center of Athens followed by an afternoon at your leisure.
5/9	Corinth Canal/ Mycenae	You will see the canal of Corinth, Mycenae (grave circles, prehistoric acropolis, bee-hive tombs) and Epidaurus. Arrive at Olympia for dinner and overnight.
5/10	Olympia	Enjoy touring the ruins and temples of ancient Greece, including the Stadium for the Olympic Games. Museum visit and afterwards travel to Delphi.
5/11	Delphi	The Sacred Way, Treasuries, the Theater, Temple of Apollo. Museum of Delphi. Travel to Kalambaka.
5/12	Meteora	Byzantine monastery, Thermopylae Pass.
5/13	Athens/ Cape Sounion	Morning of leisure in exploring the old shopping district of Plaka. Travel to Cape Sounion to visit a marble temple from 5th BC and dinner at a Greek tavern.
5/14-15	Athens	Sites to be determined by students and Dr. Swanson.
5/16	Travel	Travel from Greece to Ohio.
