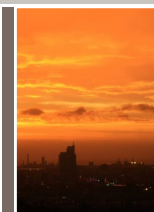

ABOUT COBE IN TAIWAN

COBE in Taiwan is the only program on campus that focuses on Asia - a part of the world that students are not likely to visit on their own or with family. In this program, students spend six weeks learning about Chinese culture and ways to do business in Taiwan.

Through this program, business students complete a business internship, meet requirements of the CCI as well as earn additional six business credit hours that count as electives in business majors and minors such as Business Management, Marketing, Entrepreneurship and International Business. While in Taiwan students will take a three-credit hour business seminar in the spring to get ready for the experience.

Students learn Chinese language through immersion, hands-on cultural activities and classes that meet in the mornings of most weekdays. Business Seminars in the afternoons focus on Chinese business practices. Providence University conducts several company visits, weekend trips for sightseeing and various cultural encounters.

DEADLINES & PAYMENTS

October 1—Scholarship application deadline

November 16—\$500 Non-refundable deposit due (scholarship cannot be used)

December 1—Remaining balance charged to AU account

ESTIMATED PROGRAM COST

Approximately \$4,500 (Increased airline fuel charges could raise the price)
Scholarships (in amounts up to \$2,000) available for 2017!

INCLUDED: Tuition, flight, housing in a double dorm room, transportation for company visits, many weekend activities, international health insurance, and Global Education Office fee.

NOT INCLUDED: Food (approx. \$600), Passport (\$135), trip interruption and cancellation insurance, laundry, public transportation pass (\$50) and personal expenses.

PRICE COMPARISON TO AU SUMMER SCHOOL: In 2015, if you stayed at Ashland, nine credit hours of summer school would cost \$4,230. For a total of approximately \$4,500 (most expenses included), you can earn 9 credit hours, experience Taiwan for six weeks and learn some basic Chinese - a language being highly sought after by businesses in the USA. In addition, this trip nearly fulfills the requirement of an International Business minor.
