PHILOS PROJECT

The Student Israel trips program is sponsored by both The Philos Project and the Museum of the Bible Foundation, offering Christian college students with leadership potential a creative next-generation approach to experiencing the Holy Land. Participants will encounter the roots of their Biblical faith first-hand and come face to face with the modern-day miracle that is Israel. Upon their return, participants will have opportunities to build upon their trip experiences by engaging in further leadership training, with an end goal of being an informed voice for both their Christian faith and for Israel.

THE TRIP

The itinerary is designed to accomplish the two goals of our organization: to strengthen the Biblical faith of the Christian participant and to introduce the student to modern Israel in order to help create an informed voice on behalf of Israel. The itinerary includes visits to key biblical sites as well as sites relevant to the modern State of Israel. Participants will hear from a diverse set of speakers throughout who will help the student understand Israeli culture, the Israeli/ Palestinian conflict, geopolitical issues in and surrounding Israel, as well as security challenges facing Israel.



AFTER THE TRIP

Once participants have experienced Israel and its incredible story, many will be eager to learn more and will want to bring that story back to their community and make it a real part of their life.

As an organization, our goal is to turn the trip experience into a vibrant post-trip alumni community that is committed to spreading the spiritual and moral message of Israel on campus and beyond. We want participants to stay engaged, and we are committed to helping them tell their story however it makes sense for them.

In addition to a menu of post-trip options that students will receive at the end of the trip, alumni will have the ability to enroll in The Leaders Course. This course has both a biblical and modern Israel track and is designed exclusively for trip alumni who want to deepen their understanding of both the Bible as it relates to Israel as well as modern Israel.

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PARTICIPANT QUALIFICATIONS

- Be enrolled as a full time, on-campus student in one of the partnering school's programs
- Be between the ages of 18-35
- Spouses are only eligible to participate if they also meet the above qualifications.

APPLICATION PROCESS

We work solely with select colleges, universities, and other institutions and organizations to recruit participants for our student Israel trips. In order to apply, potential participants must be approved by their college/university/organization and receive a link to register within our website. At the end of the registration process, participants will pay a \$500 non-refundable administrative fee. Students will then need to obtain their own domestic airfare based on the international flight information given for that particular trip. Upon arrival in Israel a collection will be made for a suggested \$100/person tip to the Israeli guide and driver.

Cost of international airfare, transportation in Israel, program costs, entry fees, hotels, all meals in Israel, as well as limited health insurance will be covered by the program.
