HOW TO APPLY

1. Go to the Study Abroad Office website - ashland.abroadoffice.net
2. On the left, choose 2022 AU Programs then Navajo Reservation Cultural Immersion. Click "Apply to Program" at the bottom of the page.

5. Submit deposit, check made out to Ashland University or a debit/credit card, to the Study Abroad Office (Bixler 211) prior to the deadline.

ABOUT NAVAJO CULTURAL IMMERSION

This tour is open to all majors and is tied to HS380: Arizona Navajo Reservation Cultural Immersion, hybrid course, offered during the Spring 2020 semester. This course plus study tour is only offered on even years. Students will study Native American culture through an assigned text complemented by assigned readings, media, and discussion. The course will conclude with a weeklong immersion at the Navajo Reservation in the four corners region of Arizona. Students will have the opportunity to interact with Navajo people during observations at the Tsehootsooi Medical Center and in the local community. In addition, students will experience the breathtaking beauty of the canyons and red rocks characteristic to this area. The final project will be a CCI Narrative with journal entries prior, during, and after their experience on the reservation and will identify their status/progress on the cultural continuum. This course has been approved to count as a Course with Study Away within the CCI Requirement of the Core Curriculum.

ESTIMATED PROGRAM COST

Approximately: \$1,459 (tentative until flights are booked)

INCLUDED: Airfare from Ohio to Albuquerque, transportation in Arizona by van, six night's hotel accommodations-double occupancy, five breakfasts, cookout at youth center, tickets to events: Hiking at Canyon de Chelly, Indian Pueblo Cultural Center, Navajo Nation Museum. Three credit hour course is offered during the spring semester (of every other year on even years).

NOT INCLUDED: Trip cancellation and interruption insurance, meals not specified, and personal expenses. Background checks and immunizations as required by Tsehootsooi Medical Center (\$10-150).
